What is involved for voice students who participate?

Preparation & Performance: Students prepare and perform TWO or THREE works by memory for an adjudicator who grades the performance on:

- 1. Tone
- 2. Breathing and Body Alignment
- 3. Language/Diction
- 4. Musicianship (Accuracy of pitch and rhythm and adherence to details of the score phrasing, tempo, dynamics)
- 5. Artistry and Expression

Benefits: Students learn their repertoire really well and perform for a "judge" who provides written comments and a grade. Each student receives a certificate of achievement displaying their grade along with the judge's comments. Self-confidence is gained through this experience as well as enthusiasm for music by being a part of a state-wide voice event.

Opportunities: Students who earn a Superior rating will be invited to perform again at one of two NCMTA Voice Performance Regional Festivals held in April. Students who earn a Superior rating at the Regional Festivals will be invited to perform in an Honors Recital at the NCMTA State Conference held in October of each year.

Fees: Fees are nonrefundable and checks should be made payable to your teacher so he/she can write one inclusive check. The registration fee is \$20 per student. Additionally, if students are not accompanying themselves, an accompanist must be hired for a fee determined by the accompanist. A recommended accompanist rate is \$40 per student and should include at least one rehearsal prior to the audition. (Pre-recorded accompaniments are not permited.)
